Good morning, on Tuesday, July 9, 2019, while I'm still here in Texas. I've been ministering for several weeks in many different places in the U.S., and I leave this week for Nigeria, where I live.

I'll be at home for only a few days, and then off to Ghana for six and a half weeks, ministering all over the country till the end of August.

Thanks for praying for me, and for giving faithfully, as I trust God to meet every need of the ministry. He's so very faithful, and He uses people just like you to support the work.

Three weeks ago, on June 16, I finished ministering in a Sunday morning service in a church, and I prayed for the people, as I always do. As I was walking to my place to sit down, I somehow lost my balance, and fell, as I bent down to pick up a bottle of water beside my chair.

People rushed to pick me up, and I had pain on my left side in the pelvic area. I sat in my chair, and didn't have pain till I tried to get up, and bear weight on my left leg.

Later in the afternoon, the pastor and his wife took me to the Emergency at a nearby hospital, to find out what had been causing the pain.

The x-rays and a scan showed two fractures in the bone on the left side of my pelvis. I spent the night in the hospital, my first time to stay in an American hospital.

I had to cancel my flight the next morning, and all the services where I was to minister in Miami, Florida. I spent a whole week in a nice rehab place, doing lots of very helpful physiotherapy every day.

There were so many opportunities to pray for people there, workers, nurses, therapists, etc. God gave me a chance to minister to each one, and to pray specifically for their needs.

I've continued with home therapy, and therapists coming almost every day, helping me with a lot of exercises. I've also been glad to pray with each one of them, too.

Please continue praying for me, for total healing and restoration, as I get stronger every day. I've been walking slowly with a walker to hold on to, but yesterday morning, I started walking with a walking stick, praise God.

So many friends have helped me, especially from my home church here. God has sent them, and I've been able to get to all the places to minister. He's poured His strength into me, during these past days and weeks. Thanks for your prayers, and please keep on praying for me!

Thanks for praying for my faithful driver in Ghana, Bro. J. K. Mohammed. He's had a very serious infection in his leg, since the surgery and the bone graft, causing a lot of pain, and a slow recovery. Our God restores, as He's promised in Jeremiah 30:17, "And I will restore health to you, and heal your wounds."

God is providing another driver, a friend of J. K.'s, to help me travel all over Ghana, and drive my vehicle. He'll be with me, till J. K. is able to resume driving again.

The four churches to be dedicated on July 27, August 3, August 10, and August 13, are getting ready for big dedication services in each place. I received a picture last night from the pastor at Gorogo, and the church is a beautiful bright blue, trimmed in dark blue.

Please pray for other churches to be helped, as God provides. Two churches now have a roof, and need help to plaster the walls, put in the floor, plus doors, windows, etc. There are others still needing a roof, and the people are praying for help. Please help me to help them.

This month of July is here, and "**July**" begins with a "**J**." It's also the first letter of the word "**JUMP**." Jesus can make you "**jump for joy**," when He answers prayer, or does a miracle in your life.

May you have so much joy this month, and "**JUMP FOR JOY!**"
