Dear Special Friends,

Good evening, on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, while I'm here in the U.S. to minister for a few weeks. I've already been here for a short time, ministering in different places, and will go back to Africa in the first part of July, to Nigeria, where I live.

Thanks so very much for praying for me, and giving offerings to the ministry, as both are needed! I appreciate every person who sows a seed in the ministry, at any time, in any place, in any country, as it helps me to keep going!

Our big annual International Service took place last week, on June 7, 2019, always the first Friday in June for many years now. It's at my home church, Faith Assembly of God, 3940 Vista Road, in Pasadena, Texas. We had great food and fellowship, with some even driving five hours to get there.

People came from many places, and some from different countries, with many amazing testimonies. One Nigerian lady told of being married for five years, without a child, and God gave them triplets!

There's a big testimony from my very dear friends in Abuja, the capital of Nigeria. They are faithful assistant pastors of a church where I always minister every year in September. I've prayed for them to have a child for many years now, and God has answered!

In the first week of May, she gave birth to a little miracle daughter, after they waited on God for eighteen and a half long years. They chose a good name for her, "Delight." They're so very, very happy!

A few days ago, I was praying for people at the end of the service, as I always do when I minister, and as I prayed for one lady, without knowing her need, I asked the Lord to touch the person she was praying for.

When I saw her a few days later, she was so happy! She was praying for her mother, who wasn't well, and needed a miracle. When she called her mother, the day after I had prayed for her in the church, she was feeling so good, and full of energy! It was a miracle, as Jesus had touched her body.

Please help me pray for my very faithful driver in Ghana, who always helps drive my vehicle in Ghana, as we go all over the country twice each year. He is such a blessing, for the six or seven weeks that I'm there every year, in January and again in July-August.

He was driving for another missionary a few days ago, when a big truck skidded on a slick road, came across into his lane, and crashed into the side of the vehicle. Thank God for the seat belts that probably saved his life, and also the missionary man with him!

His worst injury was a bad fracture in his upper leg and knee, causing him to have very serious surgery, with bone grafts from his hip, into the cracked bone in his leg. He's now out of the hospital, and needs a big miracle of quick, total healing, in Jesus' name. Be praying for him, Bro. J.K. Mohammed.

The work is going on right now, on the roofs on the two latest churches we're helping build, at Yipala, in Overseas No. 1, and at Naiyoko, near Walewale, the first place we lived in Ghana, so many years ago.

The four churches we're finishing up, and they're preparing for big dedication services, are at Tinga, near Bole, on July 27; at Gorogo, to be dedicated on August 3; at Liberty A/G in Kakpakyili in Tamale, on August 10, and at Bisaldo, near Saboba, on August 13.

There are several other churches needing help as soon as possible, in villages and towns. They have the walls up, and need help to put the roof on, and finish the buildings. Will you have a part, please?

This month of June begins with a “J,” but the word “JOY,” and also the word “JUBILATION” also begin with the letter “J.” Trust God for your own JOY and JUBILATION to come in this month of June!
