Dear Special Friends,

Good evening from Lagos, on Tuesday, February 4, 2019. I'm at home for a few days in Nigeria, after being away in Ghana for five and a half weeks of ministry.

I'll leave soon for India and East Africa, in the middle of February, my usual time every two years since 1987 to go to India. Please be praying for me, as I also pray for **YOU!** I really appreciate your **prayers**, and your **offerings**, to help support the ministry. They help me to keep going!

Last Friday night, after arriving back from Ghana, I had a fall in the apartment here. The electricity had suddenly gone off, as it does so many times here, and I had a torch light in my hand. I somehow made a wrong step, and lost my balance. There was nothing to break my fall, and nothing to catch hold of, so I just hit the hard floor, on my right side.

Praise God, there were no fractures, but something like internal bruises causing pains inside the top of my right leg. I'm able to walk slowly, with a steel walker, to hold on to, and I appreciate a lot of extra prayer at this time. I'm trusting God to help me to walk much better, before I travel to India next week!

Jesus is always my Healer, and I receive healing in Jesus' name. He's so very faithful! Pastors and friends from Ghana and Nigeria have been calling and writing, as the news spreads, to pray for me.

In Ghana last month, I traveled many, many miles, all by road in the North, ministering in very far places, even in some villages and towns I'd never been to, where we're helping to build churches.

We've started on another village church in Nabdu, No. 81. Several others are working on walls yet, at Naiyoko, Koberi, Yipaala, etc., and we'll try to help put a roof on, when they're ready. There are many more, too, as the need for a helping hand is so great.

We had big church dedications at three different places, where the new churches were finished. They were at Bimbagu on January 12; at Kolbeo on January 15, and at Ginggaani on January 19.

The people had even put floor tiles down in the churches at Bimbagu and Ginggaani! I received lovely plaques of appreciation, dresses made from the hand-woven cloth, and two sheep! I love to share nice sheep meat with some of the pastors, when we kill a sheep!

Thanks for your offerings for the ministry, and for helping me to continue building churches in northern Ghana. There are presently thirteen more under construction right now, and others needing a helping hand.

Thanks for praying for me, as I also pray for **YOU**, too! Prayer changes things, and prayer brings results! Prayer brings victory!

I praise God for testimonies! Just yesterday, a friend in Ethiopia sent a praise report about the needs that I had prayed with her about last year in April. Her husband got a big promotion, and is now a Director in the place where he's working. It was a great victory!

She herself is praising God for healing of high blood sugar, in answer to prayer. She's been off the insulin for several weeks now, and it's a miracle!

Yes, Jesus heals today, and delivers from every fear and bondage. He's still "the same, yesterday, today, and forever" (Hebrews 13:8).

This month of **February** begins with an "**F**," but the words **Favour** and **Fabulous** also begin with an "**F**" too. I'm praying for **YOU**, for "**FABULOUS FAVOUR**" for you in this month of February, in Jesus' name.

Remember His promise in Psalm 5:12, "For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous, with favour wilt thou compass him as a shield."
