Dear Special Friends,

Hello this evening, March 9, 2018, from Nairobi, Kenya, where I'm ministering right now. I'm in East Africa for nearly two months, in Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, and Ethiopia.

I arrived from Uganda earlier this week, on a very long bus trip, arriving very late, at 2:00 A.M. I'll be in Tanzania soon, ministering in several churches for two weeks, then last in Ethiopia for a week.

Thanks, thanks, thanks, for praying for me every day, and also for giving offerings, as you sow seed into the work, to help support the ministry. Your prayers and offerings are a great blessing!

There are always lots of testimonies, as I travel and minister in so many different places. I hope to hear your testimony soon, as God does miracles in your life, too.

A lady in Kenya testified about how she was in a wheelchair for several years, and couldn't come to the church, whenever I came every year. Jesus has healed her, and she can now walk, praise God!

Another lady told about how she traded her small car for a bigger, better one, and didn't have to pay the difference for several months, a big miracle in this part of the world, for sure!

A man in Kenya told me about how I had prayed for him last year, to get a good job, after having only occasionally temporary low-paying work for six years. A week later, he got an excellent job!

In Uganda, the lady whose family we've stayed with every year for over fifteen years, told about how God had given her victory over so many attacks of Satan, and the powers of witchcraft used against her in her work place. She's the headmistress over a large secondary school for girls in Uganda.

News and pictures from the churches we're helping build in northern Ghana keep coming in, even when I'm not there. One is finished with all the inside plastering, fixing the doors and windows, etc. I've received nine pictures from them, telling me that they'll have their first service inside the new building on March 25.

Several other churches have made lots of progress in plastering all the walls inside and outside, casting a cement floor, putting in all the wiring, etc. Church No. 72 now has the roof on, and the pastor sent a picture of their first service, after the roof was finished.

There are two more churches we're planning to help put a roof on soon, and many others in the villages and towns hoping for assistance to roof their buildings, and then finish them, as God provides. Many thanks for your support, to help me to help them!

When I get back to Nigeria in the first part of April, I'll immediately start the big job again, to get the printed newsletters ready to mail out to friends in many countries. It always takes about ten days, and faithful volunteers come in to help. Even now, lots of the calendar pages are being folded, envelopes printed, etc. There's filling the envelopes, sealing them, putting all the stamps on, etc.
