In September, I was ministering here in the Lagos area, and will continue till I travel out again in a few days. I was also in Abuja, the capital city, for a week and a half, to minister there, too.

While in Abuja, I was able to record three more of my books, "Words of Blessing," "Words of Victory," and "Words of Healing," to become audio books. I also made a one hour CD called "Miracles and Testimonies." Write to me, if you'd like copies, please.

The very beautiful and colorful "Thought for the Day" calendars for 2018 are ready! You need one to hang in your home, to read and enjoy every day in the New Year! Please write to me, and I can give you details about how to get one or more, wherever you are.

The testimonies continue, everywhere I go! A lady in Abuja was so weak, and her husband suggested she should stay home and miss the two Sunday morning services. She went to church anyway, and Jesus touched her! She got strong and well, to be in all the services for the three days I ministered there.

A man gave testimony about how his son got an excellent job, after he graduated from the University, in answer to prayer. May your children get good jobs when they graduate, too!

My friend, a lady who retired after working many years for UNICEF in Nigeria, has a wonderful ministry of Bible distribution to people who don't have a Bible in Africa. She testified about how she's supplied hundreds of Bibles in the Hausa language to Pastor Israel, my Nigerian missionary friend in Niger Republic, thousands of English Bibles and some in other languages here in Nigeria, Bibles in Portuguese and other languages in Mozambique, etc.

She herself has gone to prisons and hospitals to supply much-needed Bibles. If you'd like to help her with an offering to help her get more Bibles for Africa, please let me know, and I'll connect you to her.

Other churches are being plastered, windows and doors getting made, the floor being made, etc., at Bimbago, Gbeduri, Paga Navio, and Diari. Praise God for all the progress, and thanks for helping me to help them! Try your best to have a part in what God is doing in the villages and towns.

The latest printed newsletter is being mailed out from here this week. Praise God for the

faithful volunteers who are a part of the team to come in and work hard to get them ready, twice in the year. It takes about ten days to finish them. Please let me know, if you don't get your copy in the mail soon.

Be praying for me this month, especially as I minister here in Nigeria and in Zambia, then continuing on in November in Zambia, Zimbabwe, and Swaziland, going everywhere by road, on long bus trips.

Remember, the letter "<u>O</u>" is for "<u>October</u>," but it's also for the word "<u>Overcome</u>," too. I'm praying for <u>YOU</u> to be an <u>Overcomer</u> in this month of <u>October</u>, <u>to overcome fear</u>, <u>to</u> <u>overcome pain and sickness</u>, <u>to overcome anxiety and discouragement</u>, <u>to overcome financial and family problems</u>, and even <u>to overcome all the attacks of the enemy</u>, <u>in Jesus' name</u>.
